



Notification of the Office of the Prime Minister
RE: Determination of Days of Prohibition of Alcoholic Beverage Sales
B.E. 2552 (A.D. 2009)

By the virtue of the provisions of Section 4 and Section 28 of the Alcohol Control Act, B.E. 2551 (2008), which contains provisions in relation to the restriction of Rights and Liberties of the persons, in respect of which Section 29 in conjunction with Section 41, Section 43, and Section 45 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand so permit by virtue of provisions of law; the Primer Minister with recommendations of the National Alcoholic Beverage Policy Committee hereby issues a notification as follows:

Clause 1. There shall be no person selling alcoholic beverage on Magha Puja Day, Visakha Puja Day, Asalha Puja Day, and Buddhist Lent Day.

Clause 2. This Notification shall come into force from the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.
