



Order of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Committee
Re: Assignment of Officials to Undertake the Fining Procedures under the
Alcohol Control Act, B.E. 2551 (A.D. 2008)

To accelerate and improve the efficiency of the fining procedures for the offences under the Alcohol Control Act, B.E. 2551 (A.D. 2008) and to ensure conformity with the Regulation of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Committee on Criteria for Compounding of Offences under the Alcohol Control Act, B.E. 2551 (A.D. 2008);

By virtue of Section 45 of the Alcohol Control Act, B.E. 2551 (A.D. 2008), the Alcoholic Beverage Control Committee hereby issues the Order as follows:

Clause 1. Persons holding the following positions shall have the power to compound the offences under the Alcohol Control Act, B.E. 2551 (A.D. 2008):

1.1 Bangkok Compounding Subcommittee, which comprises the following:

- (1) Permanent Secretary for the BMA or his/her delegate
- (2) Commander of the Metropolitan Police or his/her delegate
- (3) Director of Health Department or his/her delegate

1.2 Provincial Compounding Subcommittee, which comprises the following:

- (1) Provincial State Attorney or his/her delegate
- (2) Provincial Police Commander or his/her delegate
- (3) Provincial Public Health Officer or his/her delegate

1.3 Competent officials according to the Notification of the Prime Minister's Office on the Appointment of Competent Officials to Execute the Alcohol Control Act, B.E. 2551 (A.D. 2008) as follows:

- (1) Director-General of Disease Control Department or his/her delegate
- (2) Deputy Director-General of Disease Control Department or his/her delegate
- (3) Director of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Committee
- (4) Government officials of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Committee under the of the Department of Disease Control of the professional level or above

Clause 2. Persons assigned under Clause 1 shall operate under the criteria and conditions prescribed in the Regulation of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Committee on Criteria for Compounding the Offences under the Alcohol Control Act, B.E. 2551 (A.D. 2008).
